

# Snowman Season

## Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Snowman Season (150458)
- Cardstock: Seaside Spray (150883); Night of Navy (100867); Whisper White (100730); Basic Black (121045); Early Espresso (119686)
- Ink: Memento Black (132708); Seaside Spray (150085)
- Tools & Accessories: Snowman Builder Punch (150643); Layering Circles Dies (151770); Banners Pick a Punch (153608); Frosted & Clear Epoxy Droplets (147801); Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Blends (154897); Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Tear & Tape (138995); Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653)
- Designer Paper: Snowflake Splendor (153512)

## Measurements:

- Seaside Spray: 8-1/2" x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Night of Navy: 4" x 5-1/4", 3-1/4" x 1"
- Whisper White: 4" x 5-1/4", 3" x 3/4"
- Basic Black: scraps
- Early Espresso: scraps
- Snowflake Splendor DSP: 3-3/4" x 5"

## Instructions:

1. Fold the card base in half and burnish with a bone folder.
2. Adhere the DSP to the Night of Navy Layer.
3. Set these on top of the card front, but don't attach it yet.
4. Die cut a circle in the upper part of card front (through all 3 layers) using the largest circle die from the Layering Circles Dies.
5. Stamp the Snowman twice onto scraps of Whisper White CS, using Memento Black ink.

6. Color the carrot nose on both, using a Pumpkin Pie stampin' blend.
7. Punch out the snowmen using the Snowman Builder Punch.
8. Punch two hats out of the scraps of Basic Black CS, using the Snowman Builder Punch.
9. Punch two arms out of the scraps of Early Espresso CS, using the Snowman Builder Punch.
10. Cover the backs of the snowmen using tear and tape.
11. Adhere the arms to the back of one of the snowmen.
12. Put a string of fishing line (or similar) between the two snowmen, top to bottom and adhere them together.
13. Adhere the hats to either side of the snowman.
14. Center this over the circle in the card base and adhere the fishing line to card front just above and below the circle.
15. Adhere the other layers to the card front using liquid glue.
16. Stamp the sentiment and snowflakes on the 4" x 5-1/4" Whisper White layer using Seaside spray ink.
17. Adhere this layer to the inside using liquid glue.
18. Use the Banner Label Punch to punch either end of the two strips of CS.
19. Stamp the sentiment onto a 3" x 3/4" strip of Whisper White CS.
20. Adhere this to the 3-1/4" x 1" strip of Night of Navy CS using liquid glue.
21. Adhere the two of these to the card front using stampin' dimensionals.
22. Adhere a frosted epoxy drop to either end of the strips.
